

Introduction

Isar Institutions Since 1994 The work has begun. Of the organizationProgramMache The focus is on the development of women. We have started our social work by solving people's problems. We have 25 years of experience in rural development by implementing various initiatives like Women Development, Adolescent Girls Development, Panchayat Raj. Management, Sustainable Agriculture, Community Based Rehabilitation, Health Awareness, Nursery, Rural Sanitation, Water Supply and Organic Farming. Watershed development was our main program. Now we have decided to turn to the development of the area to include the respectable section of the society i.e. Dalits, dryland landlords, farmers, tribal and landless women and the disabled in our program. We have an emphasis on food and life security programs. We have reached out to 1000 farmers through this initiative. We have also built their capacity by conducting various training programs.

RuralCNRI (Federation) has been established at the national level to work in development. Dr. Mohan Dharia is a senior leader and president of the National Federation. A district level unit has also been set up. I Divakar Bhoyar (Director) himself is the District President. Yavatmal district division has a total of 135 members. The federation has given importance to strengthening the organizations by involving them in government programs.



Women Self help group

YavatmalIn Babhulgaon, Kalamb tehsil the district, an organization consisting of about 300 women who have committed suicide has set up 50 women's self-help groups below the poverty line. The organization has set up groups and conducted various training programs on self-help group management, account keeping and income generating activities. The savings groups have received loans from MSRLM for their income generating activities. The family income of self-help group members has been increased. They have been given due



status in the society. They have developed leadership qualities.

• Of self-help groups Through it, women have been empowered economically, socially and politically. We firmly believe that the organization has done a successful and remarkable job in this regard.

Organic Agriculture

TalukaAn organic farming campaign has been organized by ISAR with the financial and



actual farmers. Vermi compost units have been started and bio-fertilizer has been prepared.

ChemicalExcessive use of fertilizers and pesticides has reduced soil fertility. ISAR has organized training for farmers in which they have learned about organic farming, biodiversity, crop patterns and crop selection.

technical assistance of the Agriculture Officer. Community based rehabilitation of persons with disabilities (CBR)

Since 2012, ISAR has been working on the project in 32 villages in Babhulgaon taluka of Yavatmal district. ISAR is assisting 368 persons with disabilities (PwDs) in this project. We work with them for health, education, employment, socialization, empowerment. We have worked towards giving equal opportunity to persons with disabilities in the society, giving



d place in various ceremonies, giving them an equal place by cooperating with the people of the society, giving them their rights. Created an organization of people who are considered physically disabled (DPO). In this initiative, we provided home based education for the disabled child to the parents and neighbors as well as how to teach the child daily life

activities. We are working for a disability-free environment for the disabled. Providing them with sex education and health facilities and raising awareness about HIV. In this project we are training the disabled to increase their capacity for rights and legislation. To train them in vocational skills and encourage them to start income generating activities. Also organizing various events for PWD such as celebrating World Disability Day, participating in

sex education and additional circular activities.

Monthly meetings of the group

In order to sustain the organization of persons with disabilities in the village, 26 groups (VDPOs) were formed at the village level in 32 villages. And a



group (BDPO) has been formed at the taluka level. This is because the disabled people at the village level should have organization and they should be able to solve the big and small problems at the village level. He also set up a taluka group to solve problems that are not solved at the village level. The

taluka level group leads all the village level groups. A monthly meeting is held to discuss the issues of persons with disabilities. And the organization of persons with disabilities tries to solve some of the problems raised in the meeting. Similarly, monthly meeting report, attendance book, saving,

Capacity building training for persons with disabilities

Various capacity building programs were conducted under the Disability

Rehabilitation Program to enable persons with disabilities to come together and build their capacity. He emphasized the importance of organization to persons with disabilities and organized programs to introduce them to government offices and office workers. In order to make the organization of persons with disabilities bigger, to involve as many people as possible, to identify the latent qualities in



them, to expand their qualities and to encourage them to lead. To develop their potential. An attempt was made to bring a person with leadership qualities in the group to the forefront by encouraging him to lead.

Free Verification of defecation free villages

Hygiene Isar has been appointed as the main resource center of the Ministry of Water and Sanitation under the Abhiyan Mission Program. This program is for verification of villages which have applied for Nirmal Gram Award Phase II. To date, ISAR has inspected villages in 15 blocks in 7 districts, including Amravati, Akola, Bhandara, Satara, Nanded, Buldana and Kolhapur. District wise report



submitted to the Ministry of Water and Sanitation. In this inspection, the Isar team has

examined the condition of toilets, collective sanitation, wastewater and waste management, pits and drinking water and the health condition of the village.

English e-Teachers: Isar has been working in the society since the year 2000 with the objective of child rights and children's education in mind. The organization also conducts



summer workshops for skill development, intelligence development of children with various social dreams, planting trees in rainy weather for the purpose of conserving nature, distributing educational materials to needy and budding children. E.g. Various activities such as taking training in children's drama experiments like books, compasses, bags etc. and raising awareness through themImplementing. also It is conducting various workshops in private and government schools in

the field, conducting workshops on sex education for boys and girls coming of age. The organization is working in different parts of the district and is working in the actual village. Keeping in view the dream and mission of the organization, we presenting a brief account of



the results achieved through various initiatives in the last year, in this 2020 Annual Report. The number of new students enrolling in Marathi medium primary schools is declining every year.
